

Extracurricular Regulation from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

1.- Assistance and punctuality

-The deadline for receiving messages about your child's absence or special departures by phone is 1:00 p.m.

-Electronic messages that you send to ATS, will be considered as received, until you have the confirmation from the school.

-A tour is made daily at the beginning of the class, attendance is taken and if necessary parents will be contacted in case their child is not present and there is a lack of information from home.

2.- Entry and exit of the student class

-Under the supervision of art teachers, students will eat lunch from 2:00 to 2:25 p.m. in the assigned areas: cafeteria, picnic tables and under the library. 1st grade students should only stay in the cafeteria.

-Teachers at 2:30 p.m. they will wait for the students under the library to direct them to the corresponding room.

-At the end of the class, students will wait at the roundabout of flags and / or at the roundabout of the clock together with the teachers on duty. The students of 1st grade will be delivered only at the roundabout of flags.

3.- Uniform and belongings

-For the dance and jump rope class the use of tennis is mandatory.

-In girls your hair should be collected in a ponytail or braid.

-In the practice of rope, black lycra shorts that are adjusted to the body and sports tennis shoes are required.

-Wear sports lycra shirt. Avoid tank top, strapless and sandals

-All your belongings must be marked with name, place your items (backpack, lunchbox, etc.) in the area assigned by your teachers.

-Care for the material that the school provides for use during class.

-Forgotten items, "lost and found" will remain in classrooms.

4.- Behavior in the classroom

-The student manual applies.

-Follow the instructions and routines established.

-The maromas or other stunts are prohibited without authorization from their teacher.

-Show respect for your classmates, do not make fun, or argue.

-Respect the furniture and material found in the classroom.

-Request permission to go to the bathroom and wait your turn if required.
